

Topic 5 On the Road

Visual Activity 6 – 'Street inspection'

Objective

- To look closely and to identify similarities and differences.

ABOUT THE ACTIVITY

A split screen shows two similar pictures of a busy street scene. A policeman on his beat acts as a guide as the children spot the differences between the two pictures.

Level 1

There are six differences to find; bus, car, cycle helmet, cloud, sun and umbrella.

Level 2

There are eight differences to find; clock, curtains, cat, car, doorway, traffic lights, footballers and cloud.

Getting started

- The policeman is 'on his beat'. What does that mean?
- Remind the children that they have to find the differences by clicking on the picture on the right. Can they show you this screen?
- Ask them to point out where the score will be displayed.



Try this

Make a display of items which are similar but have small differences, for example two cars of a different colour, two watches or two coloured pencils. Invite the children to talk about the similarities and differences.

Check

How well can the children:

- Remember all the differences between the two pictures?
- Talk about the similarities and differences?
