



Use the frame below to design a border for your own writing paper. Use only these three shapes and any colours you like.





A group of shapes or objects together is called a motif.

For example: $\triangle \triangle$

1. Choose three shapes.

2. Make a motif with your shapes.

3. Repeat your motif to make a pattern.

4. Use your motif pattern to design some wrapping paper or special cards.



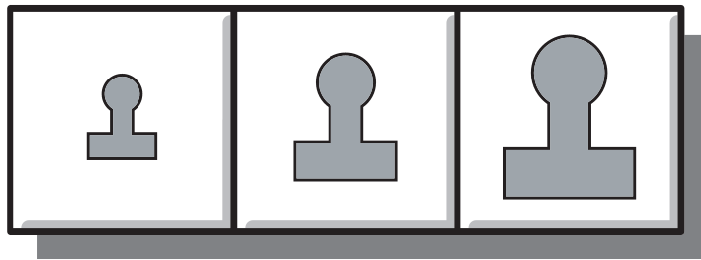
You are going to make wrapping paper using the 'Stamp' tool.

1. Select the 'Stamp' tool in your Paint program.

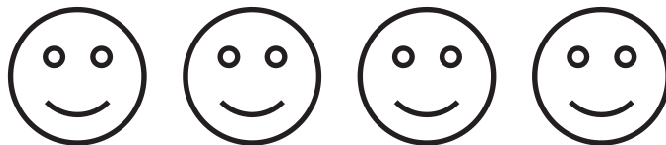


2. When you click on the 'Stamp' tool a menu will appear. Click on the stamp you want to use.

3. Click on a size for your stamp.

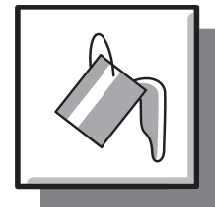


4. 'Stamp' the image on your page by moving the stamp around the screen and clicking where you want it to go.



5. Try to place your stamps so they are an equal distance apart.

6. Use the 'Flood fill' tool to add a background colour.



7. Print your picture.
